– SAFER JOURNEYS: DRIVER DISTRACTIONS

Discussion questions:

- What can you see in these pictures?
Using seat belts, toys, books.
- What will keep the children safe while they are travelling in the car?
- What kinds of activities could you do when you go for a ride in the car?
- Why can't adults play games when they are driving the car?
- What might happen if you made a lot of noise or threw something in the car while the car is being driven?
- What are the children doing while riding in the car?

Key messages:

- **Avoid distracting the driver** use a quiet voice and have electronic devices on a low volume. Choose soft toys to play with.
- **Be safe** and keep body parts inside the car.

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
