Send this form to the Schools Animal Ethics Committee (SAEC) Executive Officer promptly when an animal:

- 1. becomes ill or injured requiring veterinary treatment;
- 2. is euthanised or dies in unusual circumstances; or
- **3.** escapes, is lost or there is an unexpected incident causing harm (e.g. vandalism or predator attack).

If you are unsure whether a report is required, contact the SAEC Executive Officer on 9402 6106.

Egg hatching activity: This form is *not* required for unhatched eggs or where a chick dies, without intervention, soon after hatching (e.g. within a day). When a chick dies soon after hatching, this should be recorded on the **Activity Completion Report** with an explanatory comment in the **Issues** section.
