## **Learning intention**

## **Preparation**

Print Exploring work types and industry groups for each student.



## **Activity 1**

While this lesson visits a website focused specifically on apprenticeships, students who have not considered this pathway should be encouraged to consider this lesson as an opportunity to learn about training and careers they may not have considered.

- Introduce students to the essential elements of Australian Apprenticeships and Traineeships, using the following reference: What are Australian Apprenticeships? (Australian Apprenticeship Pathways).
- Discuss why a student might choose to complete a school-based apprenticeship/traineeship.
- A student may be:
  - o committed to a vocational pathway
  - looking for an early start to an apprenticeship/traineeship pathway while continuing to complete senior secondary schooling
  - o earn an income while studying.

### **Activity 2**

- Register with Australian Apprenticeships Pathways
- Login to your 'My Pathways Hub'
- Follow the prompts and complete the worksheet which guides students through the following linear process: Career Interest Explorer → Work Type Explorer → Research Industries
- Students should save or print the results of their quizzes in preparation for Lesson 4.

Give students the opportunity to further explore the industry they selected and to respond to the research questions in section 5 on their worksheet.
