Learning intention

Students will use their myfuture: My career profile to research occupations of interest.

Success criteria

Students can:

- log into their myfuture account
- use their My career profile to undertake further research into potential occupations of interest.

Classroom organisation

Preparation

- Students should have completed part one of this so they have a completed my career profile.
- Print Investigating occupations worksheet for each student (attached).

Activity

Investigating suggested occupations

- Students to log into [myfuture](#) and go to My career profile.
- They will find a list of suggested occupations based on their responses to the 9 quizzes completed in a previous lesson.
- Students will consider the list and 'favourite' 3-5 occupations of interest.
- Students research 2 suggested occupations of interest and complete the Investigating careers worksheet.

Reflection

Students share research with a partner and discuss:

- what they do and don't like about each of the occupations
- whether or not they will leave it on their favourites list.

This reinforces that this is a process of exploration, not of decision making.
